Use as both Our Father & Hail Mary beads of the Military Rosary.

1. Recently I have found the faceted 10mm plastic beads are great for the Our Father position of the mission rosary, #7142058 is transparent, 7142058-02 is Raspberry and 7142058-05 is the multi-coloured package. It is only available in the 3 manners, transparent, raspberry and multi coloured package.
2. Beads listed above are purchase from John Bead Corp, Toronto – they give rosary makers a 30% discount. You should ask for a Rosary Makers Discount card to obtain the discount. This card does not increase the already discounted prices at the Outlet. To obtain this card
3. Contact Donna Walton at John Bead Corp. 20 Bertrand St. Scarborough to obtain a Rosary Makers Card. This will allow you to purchase supplies from the warehouse. The minimum warehouse order is \$300. This gives you the 30% discount on products. 1-800-755-9055 toll free. Their OUTLET Store has not minimum, but supplies are limited & no card is needed 416-757-9554 or call toll free line & ask to be transferred but you cannot call and order supplies.
4. It has been a long time since I calculated it out, I believe one mission rosary cost about \$1.19 to make and \$1.60 to make one military rosary
5. RATIO FOR PURCHASING PURPOSES -- 1 Our Father bag of 1000 equals 2 spacer bags and 8 Hail Mary bags, thus 1000 Our Father beads & 2000 spacers & 8000 Hail Mary beads = **116 rosaries**
6. Also we purchase rosary making cord from Dorothy D'Souza at 519-659-8073, Rosary maker who has purchased same quality cord from a local supplier. She charges \$10/spool, this covers what she paid, she profits nothing from helping others obtain quality cord equal to the cord sold by the JBCorp.. One spool makes 550 – 600 rosaries
7. Knights of Columbus offers for sale, “How to Pray the Rosary” brochures at the cost of \$3./100 or \$30./1000. Shipping is not expensive, duty is rarely expensive. You must fax your order. Quite possibly you can email it in, call and ask 1-203-752-4000.
8. Military CORD I purchase from Frank Bauer at NorLynn Textiles in Kitchener – 72 St. Leger St. Kitchener, 519-579-3476. \$205. for four colours, black, brown, blue, green, this will make 2000+ rosaries. I get one spool of each colour. Four colours for \$205.
9. Military Rosary CROSSES I purchase from Our Lady's Rosary Makers in Kentucky, 1-502-968-1434, cost is \$0.02 per cross. I order 3000 – 5000 at a time and will last several years, neither shipping nor duty is expensive. Our Lady's Rosary Makers sell EVERYTHING for rosary making the problem is the duty and shipping it is costly for you to order everything from them. It is not usually a lot but keep it in mind.
10. Our group meets weekly usually, my home or my parish church. Some ladies may wish to take home supplies and make them in their leisure, some only on rosary night. Quality-check each other.
11. We use the assembly line format for making rosary kits for use in classrooms or with groups, and even with our members. Working with kits is much easier than having all the bags around you.

Hi my friend Johnny, greetings to you in the Lord. Hereby I send this simple message. If need be edit it and publish it. Take care of yourself. May God bless you, your brother, Fr. Baptist.

I am Fr. Baptist Rodrigues OFM Cap. I belong to Holy Trinity Province of India. I hail from Karwar Diocese of Karnataka State in southern India. We Capuchin Fathers of Karnataka run a Theologate for our province and for some religious Orders and Congregations of India. Our Theologate Dharshan Institute of Theology is situated in Bangalore, India. I am a Theology and History professor at our institute. I also teach the same topics in 5 to 6 major seminaries in India. We Capuchin Franciscans have good many vocations for our Order. In India we Capuchin Fathers have 11 provinces. Every year around 45-50 Friars make their final profession in India. Most of us are young Friars and we are vibrant in our ministry. The Friars from my province are working in countries like, Sri Lanka, Turkey, Dubai, Kuwait, Abudabi, Oman, USA, Japan, Uganda and Canada. I have a companion Friar from my province Fr. Henry Alva OFM Cap, working here in Toronto. He is residing at St. Philip Nery Parish at Jane and Wilson. During summer vacations I come here at Toronto to help him out in his pastoral ministry. So I stay at St. Conrad Friary and celebrate daily Masses at Good Shepherd Convent at Good Shepherd Court and Week-end ministry at St. Gregory's.

Back in India my home parish is Fatima Mandir Molkod, a famous Marian Shrine and Parish dedicated to Our Lady of Fatima. If you wish to know more about this Marian Shrine and its importance please log in www.fatimacentremolkod.com. Karwar Diocese is on a coastal belt of Southern India; from 17th century onwards Portuguese missionaries had been working in this area and hence we have great devotion to Our Lady of Fatima. The Christians in our area are very much believing. In most of our families we never go for dinner without reciting rosary. Rosary is the most common and powerful prayer. During the months of May and October in many of our families we recite rosaries twice; early in the morning and before our dinner. We strongly believe in the intercession of Mary in our daily life-struggles. It was God's providence that last year when I came to Toronto I met two of my very good friends Johnny and Norman. I was very much impressed by their personal devotion to Our Lady of Rosary and their volunteer service to Rosary making group. Last year Mr. Johnny sent me a big box of Rosaries. I sincerely thank Johnny and all those who are involved in this rosary making ministry for their selfless and committed service. Mr. Johnny told me about the selfless and dedicated mission of Rosary makers. May Mary our Mother bless them, their families and their efforts in spreading the devotion of Mother Mary.

For the diocese of Karwar, I am in charge of OFS Order of Secular Franciscans. I distributed your rosaries to these members and their families. Together with our Capuchin scholastics I do youth and vocation ministry. To all our young candidates and many youth groups of our Diocese I gifted the rosaries you sent me. Many of our Theology brothers make use of beautiful rosaries you give us while praying our rosaries. My sister Sr. Idoline Rodrigues UFS is a Franciscan Nun belonging to Ursuline Franciscan Sisters. She works with children and youth for faith formation. She also makes use of the rosaries you sent me. To all of my friends, I gifted the rosaries you gave me and requested them to pray for your ministry of making rosaries and sending them to different parts of the world. We all appreciate highly the selfless service you do for the propagation of Marian devotions.

As a priestly brother I appreciate very much the commendable work you do. May God bless all of you for your good will and your generosity. May Mary our mother intercede for us to her Son Jesus, Amen.

Dear Johnny.

Greetings of peace and love to you and all who work with you from all the brothers and sisters in Kingston, the Limestone City. And Because of that limestone, Kingston is a city of beautiful Cathedral Churches and one unique Catholic Church called "The Church of the Good Thief" (built by prisoners from Kingston Penitentiary). Also made of limestone are many of the nine prisons in the area. What you may ask, do the churches and prisons have in common besides being constructed of limestone? Well they both are places of prayer and worship.

To each of the prisons is assigned a Chaplaincy team usually including a Roman Catholic priest, deacon or lay chaplain as well as a Protestant chaplain. Rabbis are invited to serve Jewish offenders and imams to serve Islamic (Muslim) offenders. These chaplains represent the churches, synagogues and mosques of the area.

I work with a team of chaplains at Millhaven Institution, which is a maximum security prison. There are approximately 150 men here serving long term sentences for violent crimes such as manslaughter, murder, rape, etc. Many of these sentences can extend well beyond 0yrs. And over 25 yrs. In the same facility there are some 400 other offenders waiting to be assessed and pen placed. That is, they are sent to an appropriate security level institution: maximum, medium or minimum. So all federal offenders in the part of the country come to Millhaven Assessment Unit before going on to serve out their sentences in one of the other prisons.

That's where you come in, Johnny! You and your team of very special persons who take the time to make by hand each of the beautiful rosaries you have sent to me. No a few, not dozens, but hundreds and probably reaching the thousand mark. Not only are these rosaries welcomed by the inmates but they also appreciate very much the holy cards and pamphlets on how to pray the rosary and the preparation for the sacrament of reconciliation. So, Johnny, please know that the love with which you make these prayer beads is certainly touching the hearts of many of these men. Kindly pass along my thanks and the gratitude of so many offenders who are praying within these walls

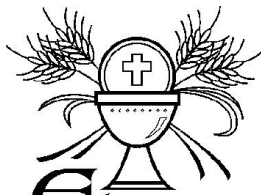

A Rosary Miracle

For three years Catholic Austria went under the tyrannical rule of communist Russia after World War II, A Franciscan Priest named Father Petrus remembered the story of how Christians in the sixteenth century had defeated the Turks at the Battle of Lepanto through the rosary, despite being greatly outnumbered.

Fr. Petrus launched a rosary crusade and 70,000 people pledged to say the rosary daily for the intention of Austria becoming free from Russian rule.

Although Austria was valuable to the Soviets because of its strategic location and rich resources, on May 13, 1955, the anniversary of the first apparition of Our Lady of Fatima, the atheistic Russian regime, in a completely unprecedented move, signed the agreement to leave Austria. Not one person was killed, and not even one shot was fired. Today, historians and Military strategists still cannot explain how or why the Russians pulled out of Austria.

**OUR LADY OF HOPE NOVENA PRAYERS**

Devotion to Our Lady of Hope is one of the oldest Marian devotions. The first shrine bearing the title was erected at Mezieres in the year 930. On January 17, 1871 Our Lady of Hope appeared in the French village of Pontmain. There she revealed herself as the "Madonna of the Crucifix" and gave the world her message of "Hope through Prayer and the Cross" the Basilica build at Pontmain by the Oblates of Mary Immaculate is one of the great French pilgrimage places, noted for its miracles of grace. The Oblate Fathers introduced the devotion to America in 1952.

Novena devotions are maintained at the Shrine of Our Lady of Hope, Oblate Fathers' Novitiate and Infirmary, Tewksbury, Mass.
