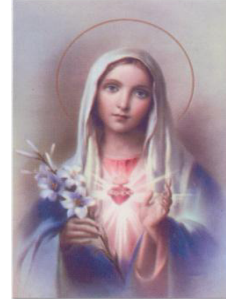

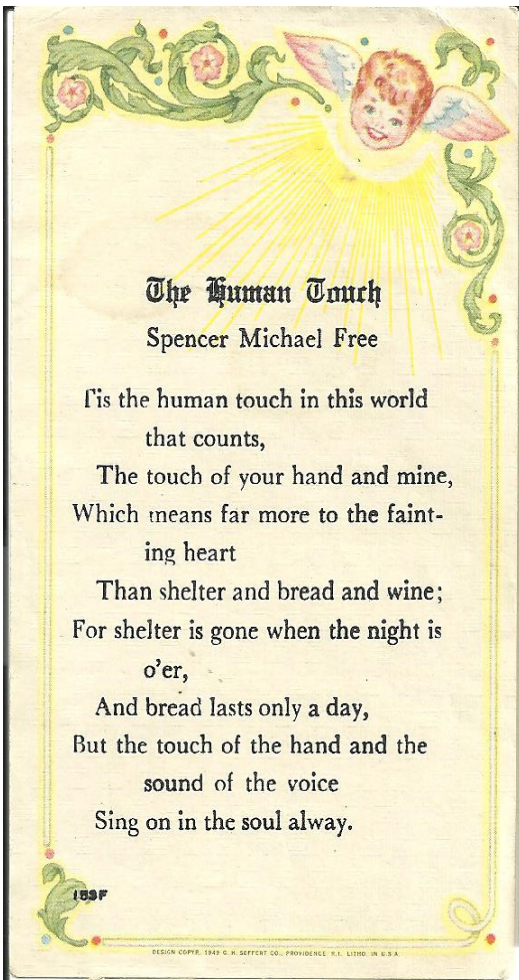

Summer 2015 Rosary Sessions

Thomasita and Manuela to make rosaries. They had fun while learning how to make rosaries. Altogether, they made almost 400 rosaries! On the last day, their parents brought snacks to share and they had a party. The children prayed for the needs of the rosary mission and for all the benefactors.

Upcoming School Visits

In October 2015, the rosary team will visit six to eight schools in the Corozal District. Will you please be part of our living rosary from October 1-31, 2015; we will pray for the hearts and minds of the teachers, principals and students will be open to receive the graces from Our Lady, for strength for all the volunteers and for more benefactors.

Donations needed: Prayer cards, holy medals, daily devotionals, Catholic leaflets, Catholic CD's, rosaries and scapulars. These are put in teacher's packets and given out to teachers. From Autom: or 1-800-521-2914 (New American Bibles, Catholic Book of Prayers, holy water bottles, crucifixes, Saint Benedict Medals, Baptism, Miraculous Medals, First Communion and Confirmation gifts) Funds to pay for printing of rosary leaflets, rosary posters, Divine Mercy Posters and Pope pictures. These are given out for free to schools. Each May and October about 3,500 to 4,500 students benefit from these items. It costs about US \$234 to pay for the printing of these items for one school.

Mission: To educate and empower the youth of Belize through rosary workshops, teaching and programs which support community. Thank you to Saint Joan of Arc Parish in Powell Ohio for helping out with mailing mission items to Belize and for all those who donated mission supplies including the Missions Office of the Catholic Diocese of Columbus Ohio building and peace.

Mission Canada Rosary Makers Spreading Smiles in Peru

We have returned to Canada once again humbled by the simple beauty which Gods love has shown us in the faces of his servants and his children, In Trujillo Peru. We met with Sister Rita of The Divine Providence House were we delivered over 400 Rosaries. These were a gift from Mr. Johnny Biafore and his people at the Mission Canada Rosary Makers at the Shrine of Gratitude on Weston Road in Toronto, Canada and the Canadian Rosary Brigade.

The Providence House is served by the Vincentian Sisters which were formed over 100 year ago in Germany. Just after the Second Vatican Council Archbishop Alcidez Castro of Peru requested the Sisters to work in Peru. Three sisters answered the call in 1969 and so began the work of the sisters in the Parish of Trujillo.

On May 31, 1970 a severe earthquake occurred destroying homes and families and killing over 25,000 persons. With the initiative of Monsignor Carlos Jürgens, Archbishop of Trujillo it was requested that an orphanage be set up to care for the orphan children which were left behind.

The idea was welcomed by religious and lay community in Germany and construction of the orphanage home on land donated by the Diocese of Bishop Jürgens, situated in San Andres-Trujillo, where the group home is currently operating. On March 15, 1971 the house opened with the name "House of Divine Providence."

The House of Divine Providence is a religious institution in the service of children, especially focused on the protection and Christian education of babies and adolescents who lack family or are in extreme poverty. Children also come from the family courts, where children and adolescents exist in a state of neglect and where moral hazard exists they will receive care and counseling. In cases where children are released by the courts system and declared in a state of abandonment the Sisters step in and the children will enter a Program for adoption.

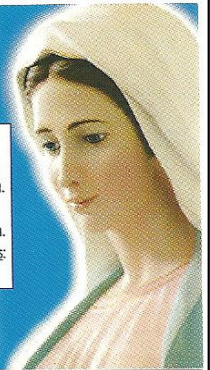
